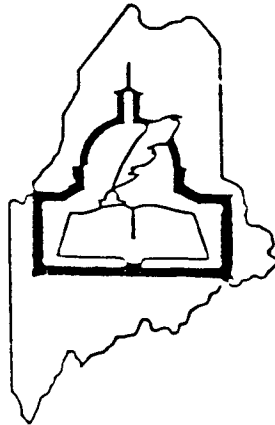

The purpose of this original resolve was to delay the implementation of the Maine Milk Commission pricing order 85-2 establishing different delivery price schedules for milk at wholesale. See LD 431 which is the new draft of this bill.

SUMMARY:

This bill has been held over to the next legislative session of the 112th. It proposes changing the minimum solid and milk fat requirements for milk, to increase solids levels and milk fat composition.

SUMMARY:

The purpose of this law is to establish colder temperatures for dry storage of milk primarily in retail establishments selling packaged milk. Restaurants, hotels, and hospitals are exempted from the bill by committee amendment "A" (H-13).
