SUMMARY :

This bill would include several omitted sections relating to dog control duties under those sections already included in Title 7, section 3704. The effect of this bill would be to make the neglect of the officials charged with enforcing those sections a civil violation, punishable by a fine against that official. Committee amendment A added certain other officials who may have responsibility for enforcing dog control laws to the list of possible violators.

SUMMARY:

Current law requires a county to reimburse another county for the costs of incarceration if a criminal "from that county" is sentenced to jail in another county. LD 253 clarified the meaning of the quoted phrase by requiring reimbursement if the crime for which the criminal is incarcerated took place in the county. Reimbursement is conditioned upon where the crime took place, not the criminal's residence. Committee amendment A further clarified what expenses were recoverable under present law by allowing reimbursement for "the costs of care and custody" rather than the previous "subsistence and detention."
