SUMMARY :

This law makes minor changes to provisions concerning commodity permits for trucks. Section 3 of the Act provides for issuance of commodity permits to single unit trucks with more than 4 axles for the fee associated with 4-axle single unit trucks.

SUMMARY :

This bill was amended significantly by Committee Amendment "A" (H-242) which changed the bill's title to "AN ACT Relating to Inspection of Catalytic Convertors and Inlet Restrictors."

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This law adds the visual inspection of the catalytic convertor and filler neck restrictor to the annual motor vehicle inspection check list for 1983 and subsequent model year vehicles. As part of the motor vehicle inspection, this measure automatically insures that no 1983 vehicle is sold that has had these particular emission control devices removed.

However, the purpose of Committee Amendment "A" is to confirm that the catalytic converter shall not be subject to complex and expensive emission control testing standards.
