SUMMARY:

The purpose of this bill was to require all persons who obtain a driver's license after November 1, 1985, to complete a defensive driving course which was to include substance abuse education.

SUMMARY:

This bill proposed to establish a matching grant program which recognizes and rewards local tax efforts for local road expenditures. An incentive grant was to provide to municipalities which expend local revenues in excess of the amounts received from the Local Road Assistance Program. The state's reimbursement under the incentive grant would be capped at 50% of the amount received by the municipality under the existing Local Road Assistance Program. If a municipality received \$12,000 in local road assistance and spent an additional \$25,000 from local revenue sources on local roads, the State would reimburse that municipality an additional \$6,000 under the incentive grant (i.e., a dollar for dollar match of \$13,000, which is the difference between \$25,000 and \$12,000, subject to the maximum of 50% of the original \$12,000 grant = \$6,000.)
