The purpose of this bill is to place further restrictions on the use of motor vehicle dealer plates and to more clearly define who qualifies for these plates. Committee Amendment (S-111) gives the Secretary of State discretionary power in deciding situations where the automobile dealer is not selling enough cars to maintain full privileges as a licensed dealer.

Funds for hiring the consultant were eliminated in subsequent amendments, but the commission is to be activated with the job of reviewing the reorganization of the statutes and reporting to the 113th Legislature.
