SUMMARY:

Makes it clear that Class B and Class C crimes in the Maine Revised Statutes, Titles 12 and 29 are juvenile crimes. These include offenses such as failure to aid an injured person and running a roadblock.

SUMMARY:

Conforms current law concerning the serving of a sentence by a parolee who commits a crime while on parole to recent changes in the Criminal Code. These changes provide that a person is no longer sentenced to a specific institution, such as the Maine State Prison, but is sentenced to the Department of Corrections for placement in a correctional facility. This changes a reference in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 34-A, section 5807, from "Maine State Prison" to "Department of Corrections."
