This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees of the Maine Legislature, covering the First Regular Session of the ll2th Legislature. The summaries are arranged by LD number and indexed separately by committee. receiving financial assistance for any post-secondary educational programs.

Senate Amendment "A" (S-9) would have prohibited the person from enrolling in post-secondary educational programs, and would have rtequired administration officials ---to require written proof of registration.
