SUMMARY:

This bill authorizes the annexation of the towns of Brunswick & Harpswell which are currently in Cumberland County to Sagadahoc County. It calls for a referendum by the voters of each town and then by the voters of Sagadahoc County. The voters may accept the change for one town and not the other.

Committee Amendment A continues in effect the obligations of the towns of Cumberland County which were in effect at the time that the Act became law. The specific purpose of this provision is to continue the obligation of the towns for the debt service on the Cumberland County Civic Center until this is retired, but for the towns not to incur any obligation for the proposed bond issue for the Cumberland County Courthouse. It also clarifies the time the referendum date from the next regular municipal election to the next statewide election.
