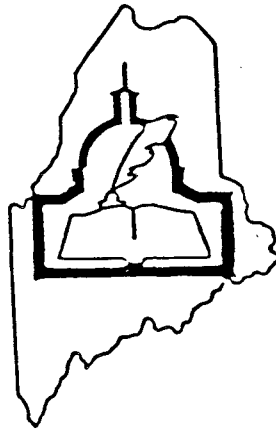

SUMMARY:

The purpose of this bill is to require that certain information be set out on any handicapped placard issued by the Secretary of State.

Committee Amendment "A" (H-225) removes reference to handicapped license plates and reinstates language which allows those with permanent handicaps to maintain their status without having to submit an annual review by a physician.
