SUMMARY :

This bill would have provided explicit authority for the Department of Conservation to promulgate rules for forest campsites and to enter into leases and other agreements for the campsite program. Existing authority to establish the campsites and a fee schedule would have been changed from the Director of the Bureau of Forestry to the Commissioner of Conservation.

SUMMARY:

The bill mandated a biennial study and report on hazardous and other solid wastes imported into Maine for disposal including incineration. The committee amended the bill (CA H-93) to clarify the categories of waste to be studied and to include incineration as a disposal method. The Commissioner of DEP was also authorized to require importers and those disposing of imported waste to report to DEP.
