SUMMARY:

This bill permits the State in an action for civil penalties to obtain relief for injured consumers as well as to obtain payment of a civil penalty.

Committee amendment A (H-142) removes those provisions that allow the State to seek damages for an injured consumer in an action to recover a civil penalty.

SUMMARY :

The act provides for civil penalties for violations of state antitrust laws. Current law allows only for criminal sanctions or equitable relief. Under the Committee's amendment, the State must elect between proceeding for a civil penalty or initiating a criminal prosecution.
