SUMMARY :

An attempt to insure that operators of heavy equipment have the right to move the equipment from one work site to another even when the equipment weight is greater than the weight limit posted.

SUMMARY :

The purpose of this resolve was to require the Department of Transportation to conduct a study concerning the feasibility of extending the Maine Turnpike from Kennebunk, Saco or Wells west to Sanford and on to the New Hampshire Turnpike at Rochester. This study was to include the feasibility of adding a 3rd lane to the turnpike from Wells to Portland.

The purpose of this bill was to require that accident reports include information concerning the use of seat belts and protective headgear at the time of the accident. This bill would also allow the Secretary of State to ascertain whether injuries might have been lessened through the use of seat belts and protective headgear.
