SUMMARY :

A Concannon Commission resolve (see LD 1337-1342), addresses the need for continuing "Hold for Court" evaluations for juveniles in the court system. It requires the Department of Corrections, in conjunction with the Office of the Court Administrator, to develop a plan for providing court-ordered evaluations for juveniles. A written report must be submitted to the Human Recources and Judiciary Committees no later than January 15, 1986.

SUMMARY:

This resolve, one of the resolves resulting from the Concannon Commission (See LD 1337-1342), requires the Department of Human Services to convene an interdepartmental Medicaid Review Committee to review current Medicaid reimbursement policies and to look specifically at expanding Medicaid reimbursement to cover services delivered in alternative settings and services, provided by specialized groups of providers. A written report must be submitted to the Human Resources Committee no later than January 15, 1986.
