SUMMARY:

This new draft (of LD 476) requires a statewide reporting system for selected occupational diseases. The new draft defines occupational diseases and lists 4 specific diseases about which the Department of Human Services is required to collect data and analyze that data. Reporting of other diseases may be conducted by rule. The new draft also indicates the purpose of collecting the data and requires contributing factors, if known, to be a part of the data reported and provides for the confidentiality of individuals listed in the reports.

SUMMARY:

This new draft (of LD 716) rewords the language of the bill to allow removal of perpetrators (child abusers) who are living in the child's home even if they are not the child's parent or custodian, e.g., a live-in boyfriend. It also allows the court to prohibit indirect contacts with the child, which may be harmful.

The bill was amended (H-98) to add an emergency clause and preamble.
