JOINT STANDING COMMITTEE BILL SUMMARIES JULY 1985

This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees of the Maine Legislature, covering the First Regular Session of the ll2th Legislature. The summaries are arranged by LD number and indexed separately by committee. consider the constraints and potential for agriculture in the various regions and to advise the department in its redirection.

It establishes the Maine Agricultural Viability Advisory Committee to review the information gathered and advise the commissioner in redirecting programs and services of the department.

Funding for this amendment was included in the department's Part II Budget request for the next biennium to cover the program costs.

A Senate amendment (S-303) sponsored by Sen. Michael Pearson was adopted which requires the Commissioner of Agriculture to first establish a pilot program in 4 regions of the State to test the concept of viability.
