SUMMARY: This bill would have permitted the transfer of milk from plant to plant for bottling or packaging because of equipment breakdowns. This proposal was opposed by the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources because of a concern about potential health risks, especially the danger of Salmonella outbreak.

SUMMARY :

The purpose of this law is to allow the use of botanical pesticides in the production of foods labeled or advertised as organic, organically grown or biologically grown. The sponsors of the bill were interested in bringing Maine's organic labeling law into closer compliance with the practices suggested by the International Federation of Organic Agricultural Movements and other organizations representing organic growers.
