SUMMARY :

This bill simplifies the schedule for when municipalities, depending upon their population, can accept only in-person registrations before election day.

SUMMARY:

This bill makes it easier to mark the voting list when a voter of an island ward votes absentee on the mainland. The clerk can contact the island warden by telephone rather than physically transferring the voting information.

SUMMARY :

This bill requires that election clerks who serve as ballot counters be chosen in the same manner as election clerks and alternate clerks.

LD: 1603 AN ACT TO CHANGE VOTING BOOTH REQUIREMENTS DIAMOND G BONNEY

HOUSE Enacted SENATE Enacted GOV SIGNED

SUMMARY:

This bill requires municipalities of 4,000 or more population to provide at least one voting booth for every 150 voters, and municipalities of less than 4,000 to provide at least one voting booth for every 200 voters.

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
