SUMMARY:

This bill requires the district attorney to send to the Secretary of State a report of all persons convicted of criminal homicide when the offense is alcohol related. The Secretary of State may require the driver to complete a drug treatment or rehabilitation program before being licensed to drive again. All programs shall begin after incarceration is completed.

SUMMARY :

This bill outlaws practices by liquor licensees which encourage excessive drinking, such as free drinks, and all-you-can-drink. "Happy Hours" are not prohibited.

SUMMARY:

This bill allows the State Liquor Commission to establish up to 5 additional discount liquor stores. The commission must come before the Joint Standing Committee on Legal Affairs before it opens any such store.

House Amendment "A" (H-258) (Not adopted) would have added a fiscal note of additional General Fund revenue of \$1.5 million annually.

House Amendment "B" (H-259) (Not adopted) would have required the 6 discount stores to be located in different counties.

House Amendment "C" (H-288) (Not adopted).

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House Amendment "D" (H-290) increases the total number of stores to 7 (6 plus the existing discount store at Kittery) and requires that the additional stores be located in different counties. It also adds a fiscal note of additional General fund revenues of \$1.25 million annually, starting in fiscal year 1986-1987.

SUMMARY :

(Not referred to Committee) This bill prohibits, until 1990, the board of trustees of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy from setting admission standards for local Indian law enforcement officers which are higher than the standards that were in effect at the time of the Indian Claims Settlement Act.
