SUMMARY:

The purpose of this resolve is to authorize the Somerset County commissioners to use funds raised through boarding inmates from other counties and the State, to make modifications to the jail facility to increase the jail's inmate rated capacity.

House Amendment A changes the source of the funds to the General Fund and specifies the year 1986 as the year for which they are authorized.

SUMMARY:

This bill removes the authority for approving the budget from the Legislature and gives it to the County Commissioners. It mandates an advisory budget committee consisting of 9 municipal officers and one person representing human services agencies within the County.
