This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees and Joint Select Committees of the Maine Legislature, covering the Second Regular Session of the 112th Legislature. The summaries are arranged by LD number under each committee.

All Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor if it is a floor amendment or the designation "CA" if it is a committee amendment. If the amendment was adopted in the House, the letter H appears after the sponsor. If it was adopted in the Senate, the letter S appears.

Final action for each bill is listed to the right of the title. If final House action and Senate action differ, both are listed.

LD AN ACT RELATING TO SHARES OF STOCK OF ASTI-KIM 1651 CORPORATION

<u>SUMMARY:</u> This private and special bill permits the Asti-Kim Corporation to vote its treasury stock. Currently the Model Business Corporation Act and all 50 states do not allow a corporation to vote its treasury shares because this ability dilutes the authority of the shareholders. This bill was held over from the 1st Regular Session.

H-550 CA H S

SUMMARY: This bill authorizes state-chartered financial institutions, savings banks and savings and loan associations to offer self-directed individual retirement accounts. Federally chartered institutions already were able to offer this service to customers.

The Committee Amendment (H-550) adds authorization for credit unions to offer this same type of account also. The amendment also adds an emergency clause so that this type of account could be offered during the current tax season.

SUMMARY: The bill adjusts the 1983 amendment to the Medical Practice Act to address an unforeseen inequity. The 1983 amendment increased the postgraduate educational requirement from 1 year to 2. A small group of physicians in family practice or emergency room specialties are board certifiable, board certified, or board eligible on the basis of practice eligibility clauses but are not eligible for licensure in Maine because they have had only one year of postgraduate education. This bill allows this narrow group, that graduated between January 1, 1970 and July 1, 1982, to be eligible for licensure in the State, if they meet other requirements.
