All Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor if it is a floor amendment or the designation "CA" if it is a committee amendment. If the amendment was adopted in the House, the letter H appears after the sponsor. If it was adopted in the Senate, the letter S appears.

Final action for each bill is listed to the right of the title. If final House action and Senate action differ, both are listed.

SUMMARY: The purpose of this Private and Special Law is to permit bond revenue originally earmarked for use in the Town Way Bridge Program to be used instead in the new Local Bridge Improvement Program enacted by the First Regular Session of the 112th Legislature. The Town Way Bridge Improvement Program was repealed and replaced by the Local Bridge Improvement Program.

The new Local Bridge Improvement Program shifts more of the responsibility for the capital improvement of local bridges to the State. Local bridges consist of those bridges on the town way and state aid systems. Historically, these bridges have been improved through a state-local partnership. Under this program, capital improvement priorities are established by a formula that considers the condition of the structure, the traffic using the structure and the protection of the public's investment.
