Final action for each bill is listed to the right of the title. If final House action and Senate action differ, both are listed.

SUMMARY: LD 1925 establishes concurrent legislativejurisdiction between the State and the United States overall lands at present owned by the United States and locatedin Acadia National Park, St. Croix Island InternationalHistoric Site, Portsmouth Naval Shipyard at Kittery, theVeterans Administration Center at Togus in Augusta andChelsea and the Soldiers' Lots at the Mount PleasantCemetery in Augusta, as well as any future acquisitions ofland by the United States to Acadia National Park or St.Croix Island International Historic Site. Through thisbill, the United States and the State will jointly hold andexercise all the rights accorded a sovereign with the broadqualification that the authority is held concurrently.Both state and federal officials may enforce theirrespective laws, with the qualifier that the State'sauthority to enforce laws is limited by the SupremacyClause of the United States Constitution, which precludesstate laws which interfere with federal functions.
