If the amendment was adopted in the House, the letter $H$ appears after the sponsor. If it was adopted in the Senate, the letter $S$ appears.

Final action for each bill is listed to the right of the title. If final House action and Senate action differ, both are listed.

SUMMARY: This bill strengthens the functions of theConsumer Assistance Division and the Library of the PublicUtilities Commission in response to recommendations of theJoint Standing Committee on Audit and Program Review.
This bill funds 2 professional positions and provides, forthe first time, full-time clerical assistance to thedivision.
This bill funds one Librarian II position.This bill also places the Assistant Administrative Directorin the unclassified service, clarifies that law studentshired by the Legal Division for the summer are in theunclassified service, clarifies that records of commissionproceedings may be maintained on audio tapes and clarifiesthat any increases in the Regulatory Fund Assessmenteffective subsequent to May lst may be billed on theeffective date of the Act authorizing the increase.
The positions established in this bill are funded by increasing the Public Utility Commission Regulatory Fund by \$145,000.
The Committee Amendment ( $\mathrm{H}-577$ ) adjusts the dollar figures downward based on a more precise calculation of salaries.HOPE, SEARSMONT AND BELMONT WATER DISTRICT

SUMMARY: The bill authorizes establishment of a new water district serving the named towns. It would have water rights in the towns. A referendum is required to pass in all the towns.
