SUMMARY: This bill sought to have all payments received for the boarding of prisoners placed in a fund which would only be used for improvement and operation of the county jails.

In the previous session, a similar bill had been introduced for Somerset County except that is specified a dollar amount rather than requiring the placement of all payments to the fund. However, this bill was passed with an amendment that provided the requested funds from the General Fund rather than from the boarding of prisoners.

The Committee felt that LD 2026 infringed on the budget rights of the County Commissioners and the Legislative Delegation.
