This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees and Joint Select Committees of the Maine Legislature, covering the Second Regular Session of the 112th Legislature. The summaries are arranged by LD number under each committee.

All Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor if it is a floor amendment or the designation "CA" if it is a committee amendment. If the amendment was adopted in the House, the letter H appears after the sponsor. If it was adopted in the Senate, the letter S appears. . . . .

Final action for each bill is listed to the right of the title. If final House action and Senate action differ, both are listed.

Last year there were 4 bills which sought to remove individual county budgets from legislative approval: Kennebec, Aroostook, Waldo and Cumberland. Kennebec legislation was developed by MMA and was the model for Aroostook and Waldo. Kennebec and Aroostook were amended so that the Legislature still has budget approval. MMA's prototype for Kennebec and the application of it by committee staff to Waldo did not deal with the statute that sets the county officer salaries. The Cumberland bill removed the county from the provisions of the salary section. This is the preferrable approach and the one that this bill does for Waldo County.

Committee Amendment A eliminated the provision that set county salaries, since the other portion of the bill made the statutory setting of salaries unnecessary.
