All Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor if it is a floor amendment or the designation "CA" if it is a committee amendment. If the amendment was adopted in the House, the letter H appears after the sponsor. If it was adopted in the Senate, the letter S appears.

Final action for each bill is listed to the right of the title. If final House action and Senate action differ, both are listed.

<u>SUMMARY:</u> This bill repeals the organization of the Town of Benedicta, conditioned upon the Town's approval in a referendum. If approved, the deorganization will be effective on March 1, 1987. This bill also updated the reference to the Unorganized Territory Education and Services Fund.
