SUMMARY: LD 64 proposed to increase the compensation ofmediators under the Municipal Public Employees LaborRelations Act from \$75/day to \$125/day. The increase wasto be phased in by increasing the compensation to $\$ 100 /$ dayretroactively from January 1,1987 and then to $\$ 125 /$ day30 ginning January $1,1988$.
The House Amendment ( $\mathrm{H}-2$ ) amended the bill by simplyincreasing the compensation to $\$ 125 /$ day beginning January1, 1988 and added an appropriation section.
