LD AN ACT TO ENHANCE THE PENALTIES FOR ENGAGING LVWD
330 IN PROSTITUTION

Sponsor: GAUVREAU, Handy, MacBride
Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: This bill sought to increase the penalty for the crime of prostitution. Currently, prostitution may be punished by a fine but not by imprisonment. This bill would have allowed a judge to sentence a person convicted of engaging in prostitution or engaging a prostitute to imprisonment of up to 6 months.

LD AN ACT TO EXEMPT DIRECTORS OF CREDIT UNIONS FROM CARRY-OVER
338 LIABILITY ON CERTAIN MATTERS

Sponsor: WARREN
Committee Report: Carry-Over

SUMMARY: The bill provides immunity from liability for a director of a nonprofit credit union for negligence of an employee of the credit union or for the negligence of another director of the credit union. A director of a nonprofit credit union would thus be liable only for negligence personal to the director or for intentional torts of the director.

LD AN ACT RELATING TO THE AMOUNT OF CIVIL PENAL PL 1987
354 DAMAGES TO BE AWARDED IN CASES OF UNLAWFUL c. 38
DISCRIMINATION

Sponsor: PRIEST, Paradis, P., Marsano, Brannigan
Committee Report: OTP

SUMMARY: LD 354 proposed to increase the monetary damages payable to successful plaintiffs in discrimination cases under the Human Rights Act. The penalties were increased from \$500 to \$1,000 for the first violation, \$1,000 to \$2,000 for a second violation and \$2,000 to \$3,000 for any subsequent violations.
