LD 442 RESOLVE, TO NAME THE BRIDGE CROSSING THE SABATTUS RIVER AT LISBON VILLAGE THE LISBON VETERANS' MEMORIAL BRIDGE. RESOLVE 1987 c. 16

SUMMARY: The bill names the bridge crossing the Sabattus River at Lisbon Village the "Lisbon Veterans' Memorial Bridge." The committee amendment (H-79) amended the name to be the "The Town of Lisbon Veterans' Memorial Bridge."

LD 471 RESOLVE, TO ESTABLISH A COMMISSION TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF CONSTRUCTING A 4-LANE HIGHWAY FROM INTERSTATE 95 TO THE ST. JOHN VALLEY. RESOLVE 1987 c. 47

SUMMARY: The resolve creates a commission to study the feasibility of constructing a 4-lane highway from Interstate 95 to the St. John Valley.

The Senate amendment (S-38) allows the commission to request staff assistance from the Legislative Council, gives the Chairman of the Legislative Council the authority to convene the first meeting, establishes a reporting date of February 15, 1988, and adds an allocation section of \$3,500.

SUMMARY: The bill makes allocations from the Transportation Safety Fund.
