LD AN ACT TO EXPAND THE MEDICAID DENTAL PROGRAM CARRY-OVER
467 TO INCLUDE ADULTS

Sponsor: BUSTIN, Gauvreau, Martin J, Diamond
Committee Report: CARRY-OVER

SUMMARY: This bill sought to establish a Medicaid dental program for adults. During the presentation of this bill the sponsors asked that the committee consider expanding the child participation in the Medicaid dental program. The committee held the bill over until the next regular session to gather more data, specifically on establishing priorities for the limited resources which could be allocated to this proposal.

LD AN ACT TO ESTABLISH HOSPITAL AND NURSING HOME LVWD
468 POLICIES FOR STAFF AND PRACTICE PRIVILEGES

Sponsor: GILL, Bustin, Brannigan, Kimball
Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: This bill would have required each hospital and nursing home to develop a policy regarding the staff and practice privileges which it makes available to licensed psychologists and include that policy in its official documents.

LD AN ACT TO REQUIRE PRINCIPLES OF REIMBURSEMENT ND LD 1603
491 FOR INTERMEDIATE CARE FACILITIES FOR THE
MENTALLY RETARDED TO INCLUDE PROVISIONS FOR
COVERING INCREASES IN INSURANCE PREMIUMS

Sponsor: BUSTIN, Taylor, Boutilier, Thistle
Committee Report: OTP-ND LD 1603

SUMMARY: The original bill requires the Department of Human Services to include adjustments for insurance premiums in the principles of reimbursement for group and nursing homes providing residential care for mentally retarded citizens. The new draft added boarding care facilities and included an appropriation and a fiscal note.
