LD AN ACT TO REQUIRE AFFIRMATIVE PERMISSION FOR ONTP  
524 ATV USE.

Sponsor: WHITCOMB, Lord, Usher  
Committee Report: ONTP

SUMMARY: This bill would have required All Terrain Vehicle (ATV) operators to get landowner permission to use an ATV on another's property. Permission already is required to operate an ATV on cropland or pastureland.

Major ATV legislation was enacted one year ago. The Committee favored waiting to see how the current legislation works before tinkering with it further.

LD AN ACT PERTAINING TO THE ADVISORY COUNCIL TO LVWD  
528 THE COMMISSIONER OF INLAND FISHERIES AND WILDLIFE.

Sponsor: SMITH, Weymouth, Rotondi  
Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: This bill was designed to abolish the Advisory Council to Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. The Council was established in 1929 to advise the Commissioner concerning the administration of the Department. The Department feels the Committee's input is both valuable and needed, and provides a valuable communication link to the State's sportsmen. The Council however, has the authority to veto regulations promulgated by the Department. The Committee, following a 1983 recommendation of the Audit and Program Review Committee, sought to remove the Advisory Council's consent authority while leaving the Council intact. The Department recommended waiting to see how the Council and new commissioner interact before removing the consent authority.
