AN ACT RELATING TO HISTORIC BRIDGES.

LD 878 PL 1987 c. 107

Sponsor: MCPHERSON, Estes, Swazey, Rolde

Committee Report: OTP

<u>SUMMARY:</u> The bill adds 2 bridges to the list of bridges with historic significance, Sewall's Bridge in York and Waldo-Hancock Bridge in Prospect-Verona. These additions were nominated for inclusion by the Commissioner of Transportation.

LD AN ACT TO MAKE TECHNICAL ADJUSTMENTS TO THE 879 TRUCK OVERWEIGHT LAW.

PL 1987 c. 108 EMERGENCY

Sponsor: MCPHERSON, Pouliot, Theriault, Cahill Committee Report: OTP

SUMMARY: The bill brings Maine into conformity with federal requirements concerning minimum fines for trucks which are over weight. It makes the minimum fine \$20. There was a threatened loss of highway funds unless Maine was brought in conformity with the interstate truck weight enforcement laws.

LD 881

AN ACT TO AMEND THE EXPERIMENTAL VEHICLE LAW.

PL 1987 c. 109

Sponsor: MOHOLLAND, McPherson, Mills, Harper Committee Report: OTP

SUMMARY: Under present statute the Commissioner of Transportation may issue experimental vehicle permits "over any nonlimited way or bridge maintained by the Department of Transportation." The bill eliminates the restriction that the way or bridge must be maintained by the Department of Transportation and allows the experimental vehicle to use, at the commissioner's discretion, on any public way.
