LD AN ACT TO AMEND THE TRUCK SIZE AND WEIGHT LAW. PL 1987 c. 199

Sponsor: POULIOT, Macomber, Salsbury, Cahill

Committee Report: OTP-A

Amendments Adopted: H-139 COMMITTEE

SUMMARY: The bill makes two technical corrections to the truck size and overweight fine laws. The first makes it clear that the maximum length of a combination vehicle includes the load. The second clarifies that when there are infractions concerning both the gross and axle weights, the responsible person shall pay the larger fine and not the fine on the larger infraction.

The committee amendment (H-139) exempts smaller trucks from the size and weight limits until September 1, 1988.

LD AN ACT TO FACILITATE THE MOVEMENT OF EMERGENCY PL 1987 888 RELIEF VEHICLES. C. 185

Sponsor: CAHILL, Reeves, Gauvreau, Pines Committee Report: OTP

<u>SUMMARY:</u> The bill permits authorized emergency vehicles, as designated by the Commissioner of Public Safety, based in another state to operate in or through this State during declared emergencies without obtaining fuel use licenses.

LD AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE USE OF SEAT BELTS IN PL 1987 890 DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAMS. c. 216

Sponsor: REEVES, Bost, Pines, Carroll Committee Report: OTP

<u>SUMMARY:</u> The bill requires instructors and students to use seat belts during the behind-the-wheel instruction portion of the course. This shall apply to both commercial schools and to driver education in public schools.
