AN ACT CONCERNING PRIZES AWARDED BY CHARITABLE ND LD 1598 LD 896 ORGANIZATIONS

Sponsor: MANNING, Dutremble, D., Dillenback, Holloway Committee Report: OTP-ND LD 1598

SUMMARY: See New Draft, LD 1598.

AN ACT TO REGULATE POLITICAL ADVERTISING IN ONTP LD904 PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY AREAS

Sponsor: PARADIS, P. Committee Report: ONTP

SUMMARY: Current law prohibits the placement of commercial signs on any traffic sign or signal. This bill would extend the prohibition to political signs as well.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE RECOVERY OF CIVIL LD LVWD 927 DAMAGES FROM SHOPLIFTERS

Sponsor: DELLERT, Seavey, Clark, N., Brannigan Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: This bill would allow a store or other establishment to collect damages of not less than \$50 nor more than \$500, plus court costs, from a shoplifter or his or her parents. Current law already provides adequate remedies.

LDAN ACT RELATING TO UPDATING VOTING LISTS LVWD 932

Sponsor: CARTER, Mayo, Melendy, Berube Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: Current law provides that a registrar may remove names from the voting list of people who become disqualified to vote or have apparently abandoned their residence in the municipality. This bill would also allow the removal of the names of people who have failed to vote in at least one of the last 3 elections.
