SUMMARY: Referendum votes taken on 2 occasions authorizing the construction of an elementary school had errors in them which call into question the validity of proceeding with construction of the building. This bill validates these referenda.

This new draft is more specific and detailed than the original bill concerning the referenda being validated and the effect of this validation.

SUMMARY: Currently, mooring sites are to be reserved for non residents of a municipality in a number equal to 10% of those available for residents. This bill requires that municipalities completely take care of the mooring needs of residents before making moorings available to non residents.

SUMMARY: Currently, State law sets the fee that municipalities may charge for the costs included in processing state required licenses and permits. Generally, such fee is \$1. This bill authorizes the municipality to charge its actual cost for certain of these transactions, namely, dog licenses, hunting and fishing licenses, and motor vehicle registration.
