LD AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE PROCEDURE FOR VOTER

SUMMARY: This bill clarifies that a person can register to vote or enroll in a political party, or both, by postcard.

LD AN ACT TO REQUIRE A CANDIDATE'S FINANCIAL

SUMMARY: This bill would require candidates to include in their financial report an authorized dated receipt of each expenditure. In addition, any expenditures made on or income received from a fund-raising event would have to be recorded, including specific amounts received for admission and number of tickets sold.

LD AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE GATHERING OF PETITION
1124 SIGNATURES FOR INITIATED BILLS AT VOTING PLACES

LVWD

Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: This bill would prohibit any person from collecting signatures for any initiative or referendum within 250 feet of the entrance to either the voting place or the registrar's office. To do so would be a Class E crime. See also LD 1643.
