LD AN ACT RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE SALES

SUMMARY: This bill would increase the license fee for liquor sales representatives. It would also prohibit a person who represents a supplier of liquor to the commission may not also represent wholesalers of malt liquor and wine.
