SUMMARY: Waldo County is one of 6 counties with a municipal budget committee. In the case of Waldo this Committee has final authority over the county budget. It does not come to the Legislature. All members are municipal officers and they are elected by the municipal officers.

This bill places the terms of the members of the committee on a staggered basis.

Committee Amendment A: The original bill had assumed that the county fiscal year ends on June 30th, whereas it, in fact, it ends Dec. 31st. This amendment revises the dates in the bill so that the changes in member terms can be in effect for the next biannual election which is in the fall of 1987 and places the bill on an emergency basis so that it will be in effect at the time of this year's election.
