All Adopted Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor for floor amendments. Final action is listed to the right of the title. If final House and Senate action differ, both are listed. Committee Reports and Floor Action are indicated as follows::

Senate amendment A incorporates the committee amendment except that it deletes the 58% state share provision, increases the hold harmless provision to 90% for all units, provides for implementation of the hold harmless provision in 1988-89 and changes the chairmanship and reporting date of the study commission.

Senate amendment B to Senate Amendment A makes a technical language correction in the bill.

The bill was carried over from the First Regular Session to assess changes in administrative practices of the Department of Educational and Cultural Services. Following discussions between proponents of the bill and the DECS, it appeared to the committee that the objectives of the bill were being accomplished by DECS administrative actions.
