LD AN ACT CONCERNING PROOF OF INSURANCE ON SCHOOL PL 1987 1164 BUSES. c. 262

Committee Report: ONTP - OTP-A

Amendments Adopted: H-130 COMMITTEE

<u>SUMMARY:</u> The original bill allowed for the registration of school buses by municipal agents. Committee amendment "A" (H-130), as enacted, permits municipal agents to issue only renewal registrations on school buses.

LD AN ACT TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC-CONTROL SIGNAL LAW. LVWD 1245

Sponsor: WEYMOUTH, Dow Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: This bill would have required that "NO RIGHT TURN ON RED" signs be attached to the traffic light and be of a specified size.

LD AN ACT RELATING TO THE MAINE STATE FERRY LVWD 1248 SERVICE.

Sponsor: SCARPINO

Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: This bill would have changed the definition of a highway to include established ferry routes to enable the Maine State Ferry Service to be eligible for state and federal highway aid.

1255 TRAFFIC CONTROL DETAIL DURING HIGHWAY
CONSTRUCTION.

Sponsor: USHER, Tuttle, OGara Committee Report: ONTP

<u>SUMMARY:</u> This bill would have required Maine State Police to engage in traffic control at construction sites on the turnpike or interstates.

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
