LD AN ACT TO AID IN ENFORCEMENT OF CHILD SUPPORT 1287 PAYMENTS

Sponsor: DUFFY, Paradis, P., Vose, Parkins Committee Report: ONTP (Majority) ONTP-ND (Minority)

SUMMARY: The new draft sought to require the Department of Human Services to publish in newspapers, not more than 4 times a year, the names of no more than 10 persons delinquent in child support payments for at least 3 years and in an amount of at least \$5000.

LDAN ACT TO REQUIRE PHYSICAL CONTACT BEFORE ALVWD1292DOG OWNER MAY BE LIABLE FOR DAMAGES CAUSEDBY HIS DOG

SUMMARY: LD 1292 proposed to require physical contact between a dog and a person or property before the dog's owner may be found liable for any injury or damage to the person or property.

SUMMARY: LD 1302 authorizes the State to appeal to the Supreme Judicial Court when the Superior Court, sitting as an intermediate appellate court, issues a ruling adverse to the State in any criminal action.
