SUMMARY: The original bill would make a number of changes in the laws governing private security guards. The changes were meant to improve the quality of private security guard service in the State. The Statement of Fact includes a section-by-section description of the bill. The major changes include the elimination of the exemption for agents of proprietary security organizations.

This New Draft also eliminates that exemption, plus makes several other changes to the current law concerning use of security guards at the site of a labor dispute or strike. The New Draft contains a section-by-section description in the Statement of Fact.
