SUMMARY

The bill removes quorum and voting requirements for incurring and refunding bonds and notes. The amendment requires that the Madawaska Water District follow the procedures required of water districts formed after 1982 to hold a public hearing and, if 5% of the voters request one, provide the opportunity of a district vote before it can issue bonds exceeding \$150,000 in 1981 dollars.
