This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees and Joint Select Committees of the Maine Legislature. The volume is organized alphabetically by committee; within each committee, the summaries are arranged by LD number. A subject index is provided at the beginning of each committee's summaries.

All adopted amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H - 584 or S - 222), together with the sponsor for floor amendments. Final action on each bill is listed to the right of the title. Various types of final action are abbreviated as follows:

**LD 484      An Act to Amend the Composition of the Board of Trustees of the Maine Technical College System      ONTP**

SPONSOR(S)	COMMITTEE REPORT	AMENDMENTS ADOPTED

**SUMMARY**

This bill would have revised the composition of the Board of Trustees of the Technical College System by removing the ex officio members, providing for a specific number of representatives from administration, faculty, business, labor and the public, and requiring regional representation among the members.

**LD 499      An Act Providing for Low-income Student Adjustment in Education Funding      ONTP**

**SUMMARY**

This bill would have established a low-income student adjustment to be paid outside the finance formula. Providing the funds as an adjustment means that the amount received by a school administrative unit does not depend on its state share percentage.

**LD 500      An Act to Provide Funding for Asbestos Treatment, Underground Tank Removal and Replacement, Roof Repair and Other Costs Associated with Federal Mandates      ONTP**

**SUMMARY**

The bill would have changed the method of reimbursing school units for minor capital costs and expanded the list of costs to be included in the definition of minor capital costs for the purposes of this type of reimbursement.

**LD 527      An Act to Revoke Drivers' Licenses of Students Who Do Not Complete High School      ONTP**

**SUMMARY**

This bill would have permitted the Secretary of State, Division of Motor Vehicles, to deny or revoke the driver's license of a school dropout.
