### JOINT STANDING COMMITTEE BILL SUMMARIES

### AUGUST 1991

This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees and Joint Select Committees of the Maine Legislature. The volume is organized alphabetically by committee; within each committee, the summaries are arranged by LD number. A subject index is provided at the beginning of each committee's summaries.

All adopted amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H - 584 or S - 222), together with the sponsor for floor amendments. Final action on each bill is listed to the right of the title. Various types of final action are abbreviated as follows:

### LD 1737 Resolve, Establishing a Commission to Study the State of Maine Manual of Policy and Procedures for Maine State Employees Combined Charitable Appeal

#### SUMMARY

This resolve would have established the Commission to Study the State of Maine Manual of Policy and Procedures for Maine State Employees Combined Charitable Appeal. The commission's duty would have been to revise the current campaign manual to include the recommendations of the study commission.

#### SUMMARY

This bill would have provided that if a municipality could demonstrate to the State Planning Office that it would suffer financial hardship by funding a state mandate the State Planning Office could defer the mandate for up to 12 months. The municipality could have reapplied for further deferrals if the financial hardship continued. The bill applied to state mandates enacted by the Legislature prior to July 1, 1991.

## **LD 1744** Resolve, to Clarify a Right-of-way to Raymond H. Fickett RESOLVE 33 over Property of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife

#### **SUMMARY**

This resolve directed the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to convey to Raymond H. Fickett an interest in land along a right-of-way reserved by his predecessors in title in a deed conveying land in Casco currently occupied by a fish hatchery to the State. The interest conveyed was sufficient to permit the construction of a road connecting Raymond H. Fickett's property on the northern side of the State's property to the nearest public way.

Committee Amendment "A" adds a fiscal note to the bill.
