The committee report or reports, the prime sponsor for each bill and the lead co-sponsor in each house if one has been designated are listed below each bill title. All adopted amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor for floor amendments. Final action on each bill is listed to the right of the title. Various types of final action are abbreviated as follows:

This bill would have allowed handicapped license plates to be issued upon application to all vehicles owned by a handicapped person or owned by a relative or legal guardian who is the handicapped person's primary means of transportation.

SUMMARY

This bill proposed to clarify the ability of municipalities to provide for snow and ice removal from private driveways if the legislative body of the municipality voted to do so. The bill described circumstances under which removal of snow and ice provides a public benefit and declared that expenditure of public funds for this purpose satisfies the public purpose requirement of the Constitution of Maine.
