This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees and Joint Select Committees of the Maine Legislature. The volume is organized alphabetically by committee; within each committee, the summaries are arranged by LD number. A subject index is provided at the beginning of each committee's summaries.

The committee report or reports, the prime sponsor for each bill and the lead co-sponsor in each house if one has been designated are listed below each bill title. All adopted amendments are listed, by paper number, together with the sponsor for floor amendments. Final action on each bill is listed to the right of the title. Various types of final action are abbreviated as follows:

## Resolve, to Conduct a Study on Improving Access to the Maine Technical College System

#### **SUMMARY**

This resolve creates the Technical College Study Committee to study the deficiencies in funding, equipment and curriculum and problems with the campus locations of the Maine Technical College System as a follow-up to a 1991 report. The committee will report its recommendations to the 117th Legislature.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-788) adds a provision permitting members of the Maine Technical College System to receive reimbursement for expenses from the Maine Technical College System. The amendment makes clear that no expenditures may be made from the State's General Fund to support the committee. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
