This constitutional resolution establishes the office of Lieutenant Governor. The Lieutenant Governor is elected with the Governor by a single vote and assists the Governor with the responsibilities and duties of the office of Governor. The Lieutenant Governor succeeds the Governor in the event the office of Governor is vacant.

The bill also provides that the Kennebec County Commissioners and sheriff must meet twice a year to review county law enforcement activity and that the State Police must be included in the meeting.

The resolve would also have ensured that the period of time during which any interested party may commence an action in Superior Court was likewise extended. This resolve was sent directly to the floor without reference to committee.

SUMMARY

This bill authorizes Kennebec County to issue general obligation bonds, without voter approval, to pay the costs of substantial repairs and improvements to the Kennebec County Court House.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (H-1024) requires that if the Kennebec County Commissioners choose to approve a bond issue for the court house then this bond issue must be submitted to the voters of Kennebec County for approval.
