LD 1988 An Act to Address Funding Needs for State Employees Affected by Federal Funding Disruptions

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Public Law 2025, chapter 435 addresses funding needs related to layoff obligations for state employees affected by potential federal funding disruptions in the following ways.

1. It authorizes the transfer of up to \$2,500,000 from the balance available in the Reserve for General Fund Operating Capital to the Departments and Agencies - Statewide program, General Fund account within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services.
2. It authorizes the transfer of Personal Services expenditures from any federal fund account to the Departments and Agencies - Statewide program, General Fund account within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services.
3. It requires the State Controller, on or before June 30, 2026, to transfer the unobligated balance from the Departments and Agencies - Statewide program, General Fund account within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services to the Reserve for General Fund Operating Capital.

Public Law 2025, chapter 435 was enacted as an emergency measure effective July 1, 2025.
