To the Board of State Assessors
Re: Hibbard Gore

I have made a somewhat careful investigation relative to the Hibbard Gore, so-called, lying between the towns of Palermo and Washington and also as to Muscongus or Louds Island, lying easterly of and adjacent to the town of Bristol.

In both instances, from an examination, it is my opinion that neither Hibbard Gore or the Island belongs to or is a part of any incorporated town of this State and I should advise that both be classed as wild lands and be included in your list for assessment of the State and County taxes.
